



# Nor Este Neighborhood Association

## 11/01/11 General Meeting Minutes

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm by President Jeff Peterson.
2. APD NE Area Command Update- Cmdr. Bonnie Montoya, Lt. Kevin Rowe, and Crime Prevention Specialist Sharanne Press
  - Tactical (Tact) plans in place for the holidays to cover the malls and other “hot spots”.
  - Lt. Rowe has a Problem Orienting Policing Project (POP) every month. This month is focusing on two apartment complexes due to recent crime.
  - What can we do as a neighborhood association for our officers? - Let the command know if something happens through email or by calling 242-2677 for non-emergencies and 911 for emergencies. If you would like a topic discussed in the APD NE Command Newsletter, forward to a NENA Board Member.
  - Use the website at [www.cabq.gov](http://www.cabq.gov) and to go the APD website and look at “CRIMEVIEW COMMUNITY” to see crime activity in our neighborhood.
  - NENA donated to the fundraising for improvements to the NE Command break room.
  - Lt. Rowe is working toward the decrease of cell phone use and texting while driving. If you see an officer on his/her phone, call 311 to report it.
3. District 4 Update- Brad Winter
  - December 1- Swearing in ceremony for City Councilors at the Convention Center. NENA is invited as Councilor Winter’s guests.
  - Wyoming speed limit to 30 mph was due to complaints due to speeding. Reduced due to Wyoming being a feeder street to residential areas and due La Cueva being along the street. From the Dept. of Municipal Development “ The speed limit on Wyoming between Oakland and Paseo Del Norte was reduced due to several complaints of excessive speeds adjacent to the residential/school area north of Paseo Del Norte. The previous speed limit was 40 mph – the change was to 30 mph which is appropriate for a feeder street to a residential area”
  - Re-districting is being reviewed due to growth on the West Side. 5 potential re-districting maps will be sent to the council by a consultant and a decision will be made sometime in January.
  - La Cueva morning traffic in neighborhoods - signs are up. The peak is for 20 minutes in the morning, not an issue in afternoon. Brad to keep an eye on the situation.
  - Red light camera vote is on 11/07/11. Citywide voted 51%/49% for and against the cameras.
  - Eagle Rock/Wyoming subdivision- Brad will check with traffic engineering to see if striping can be placed along Wyoming to make it easier to see where to turn in to Eagle Rock from Wyoming. Intersection is problematic due to geometry change and lack of lighting.
  - Trees along Oakland in Nor Este- Brad will check out the trees to see how the city can help with the maintenance.
4. Treasurer’s Report
  - \$6030.61
  - 90 Dues Paying Members- For those who paid in October, dues will cover through December 2012.
  - Jeff will check with Bob Franklin’s contact for delivering the newsletter for \$0.145 through USPS.

- Alameda Mill & Overlay- Moving east, Began at Edith, heading towards San Pedro
- Oakland- Wyoming to San Pedro in design, full road width improvements
- La Vista Subdivision- Eagle Rock/Wyoming under construction
- Guardian Storage- (South of Paseo between Barstow and Wyoming) Zone Change and Site Development Plan approved at EPC on 10/13/11 has been appealed by Countrywood Neighborhood Association due to building height and traffic
- Twister's- almost done
- Mario's- grading began this week
- Goodwill- Open
- Duke City Auto Auction (San Pedro & Alameda)- still possible
- EPC Text Amendment- change zoning so that there is a 500 ft set back requirement between daycares and adult bookstores
